She served as a director for seven years, one year as third vice president and eight years as second vice president. She served on most committees and was the Senior Tournament Chair from 1997 until her retirement from the board in 2002.

Juanita also served on the Ohio Bowling Council. She was Chairperson of the Council Mixed Tournament for four years, Ohio Bowling Council District Workshop Chair, was on the Council Hall of Fame Committee. She was inducted into the Ohio Bowling Council Hall of Fame in 2002 for Meritorious Service.

She served as a Director and Treasurer of the Buckeye 600 Bowling Club and was elected Life Member. She was Secretary of the Ohio Local Association Presidents Club for ten years and was active in the Buckeye Women Bowling Writers.

She served on her local association, Dover-New Philadelphia WBA Board of Directors for 18 years, 15 years as President. She was inducted into the Dover-New Philadelphia WBA Hall of Fame in 1977, and is still an active bowler in leagues and tournaments.

Juanita's bowling ability has gained her membership into the Ohio Women's 700 Bowling Club. She has participated in 19 WIBC Championship tournaments, attended 18 WIBC Annual Meetings and participated in 39 Ohio USBC WBA Championship tournaments.

Her enthusiasm toward the sport of bowling has encouraged all who know her to strive towards the enhancement of the sport, but most of all, she encourages everyone to "just have fun".
