Sandy has devoted most all of her adult life to the sport of bowling and was especially good at the promotion of the sport and the bowlers. One of her friends has stated that "I really can't express how much Sandy has contributed to the promotion of bowling in Ohio."

She was always thinking of promotions to increase participation in the state championship tournaments and was responsible for bringing several teams to the state tournament each year. When the WIBC tournament was held in Toledo she worked on a project called "Pledge a Team". Each local association in Ohio was asked to pledge teams to participate in the national tournament. This project encouraged many bowlers around the state to participate in the WIBC tournament.

She was co-founder and charter member of the Ohio Local Association President's Club where she served as president for six years. She was also co-creator of the Buckeye Bowling Boosters serving as a director, charter member of Buckeye Women Bowling Writers and past director, charter member of the District #2 600 Club and past director, charter member of the GAL 600 Club and past president.

Sandy served as a director on the Ohio WBA Board of Directors from 1990 thru 1993.

She served as president of the Ashtabula WBA, elected life member, and was inducted into the Ashtabula WBA Hall of Fame.

She served on the WIBC Tellers Committee for nine years, served as a delegate to the WIBC annual meetings for twenty years, and participated in seventeen WIBC tournaments.
